WICKED, the emerald extravaganza that tells the story of the two witches of Oz, is back on its broom at the Lyric Theatre, QPAC from Tuesday 25th January 2011 . As the flooding in Brisbane and Queensland recedes, the theatrical musical event of the decade is ready to fly again.

Australian producer of WICKED, John Frost said, “After an extraordinary effort over the last two weeks by QPAC staff and volunteers working around the clock to clear the mud and get services up and running, we are delighted that the Lyric Theatre is again working and WICKED can start.

Patrons who have pre-purchased car parking vouchers can use them at BCEC car parks. BCEC Parks 1 and 2 only accept cash. There are limited car parks available and patrons are encourage to use public transport or car pool.
